





Fuel consumption per capita and year (litre)



Mariahilferstraße, Vienna – Encounter Zone




BEFORE:

Same play – protest against cycling measures before implementation from the conservative party We wait ...who will remember after implementation






City wide speed limit of 30 km/h

Ljubljana: Slovenska main traffic corridor before - after






